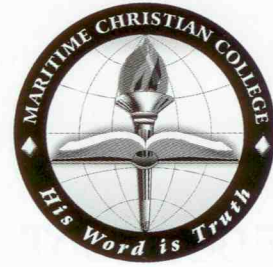

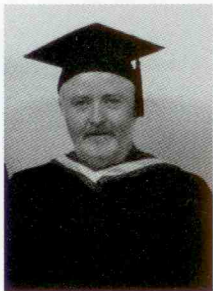
Graduation 2005
